COVID-19 Stimulus Package

\$750 Payments to Support Households

What is it?

Two separate payments of \$750 to eligible Australians.

Who is eligible?

First payment:

- You must be residing in Australia and at any time between 12 March & 13 April 2020 be receiving/eligible for any of the following;

- Age Pension
- Disability Support Pension
- Carer Payment
- Parenting Payment
- Wife Pension
- Widow B Pension
- ABSTUDY (Living Allowance)
- Austudy
- Bereavement Allowance
- Newstart Allowance
- JobSeeker Payment
- Youth Allowance
- Sickness Allowance
- Special Benefit
- Widow Allowance
- Family Tax Benefit, including Double Orphan Pension
- Carer Allowance
- Partner Allowance
- Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) holders
- Commonwealth Seniors Health Card holders
- Veteran Service Support holders
- Veteran Gold Card holders
- Farm Household Allowance
- DVA PCC holders

Second payment:

You must be receiving/eligible in the same way as the first payment (above), except for those receiving an income support payment that is eligible to receive the Coronavirus supplement.

These supplements are:

- Parenting Payment (single)
- JobSeeker Payment
- Youth Allowance Jobseeker
- Special Benefit
- Farm Household Allowance

First payment: From 31 March 2020

Second payment: From 13 July 2020

What does this entitle you to?

Two separate payments of \$750. A couple on the pension will receive the \$750 each

Is there GST on this?

The income you receive from Centrelink will not be reported in your BAS and does not attract GST. You will not need to enter this income in the Rideshare Tax app.

How to apply?

Existing recipients will automatically receive their entitlement.
